He is very intuitive and can form and give opinions at once.

Mr. Baron has a high head above his ears indicating firmness, fixedness of purpose, determination, and great perseverance and application.

His face is wide between the ears,



hence he has force of character, spirit, courage, and executiveness, a strong desire for and the business ability to accumulate property.

His eyebrows are thick and long, indicating physical strength and energy—they rise to a point revealing a keen sense of colour and a love of the artistic. He could have been a success in the fine arts.

His nose is of the business type—the width at the top denotes a saying nature. His nostrils are wide and curved, showing sensitiveness and pride.
